

Camping Procedures

Toilets/shower block -To be kept clean. a member of staff will be available to open/lock access doors.

Two Way Radios -On arrival you will be given a radio for use while you are down at the camp site. These are only to be used in emergency..

Use of Facilities - Camping groups have only booked for camping, facilities up at the centre are for residential groups only. In extreme conditions, it may be possible to let your group use the showers/toilets in the sports changing rooms, but it is then your responsibility to clean these afterwards.

Use of Water Tap -Keep a bucket under the water tap because if the tap is used repeatedly without a bucket, the ground around it will quickly become wet and muddy.

Camp Fires -Fires should only be lit in the designated fire area and must be kept under control at all times. Ensure that fires are properly extinguished before leaving the site. Tents need to be sited **at least 15 metres** upwind from the fire, and only the wood provided by us can be used. You are not allowed to take wood from the woods.

Leaving the site -You must inform Play Away staff when any of your group are leaving site. Leave a contact number and the walkie-talkie behind.

Walking -When you go for a walk please respect the boundaries you have been shown. If groups want to go for a walk point out where they can and can't go, show them our boundaries.
